CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

FORMS

- 1. Entry forms are available on our website https://www.gulgongarts.com/scarecrows-2024 or can be collected from **The Gallery Gulgong** (85 Herbert Street, 9.30-4.00 Thurs to Mon)
- 2. Entries will be accepted from individuals, families and schools. A business can enter the competition as a family or can decorate their workplace with a non-competition scarecrow free of charge.
- 3. Entry forms must be received by Tuesday 4th June, 2024
- 4. Email completed forms to artscouncilgulgong@gmail.com or deliver them to The Gallery Gulgong.
- 5. Entry forms with no matching payment will not be accepted.

PAYMENT

- 6. The entry fee is \$10 per scarecrow.
- 7. Pay by **bank transfer** with your name to "Arts Council Gulgong Inc" (**BSB** 062549 **A/C no.** 00901710) or include a **cheque/money order** when you post your entry form.
- 8. Payments with no matching entry form will be treated as a donation.

REGISTRATION

- 9. Meet at Gulgong Post Office 8.30am Saturday 8th June 2024 to register your scarecrow.
- 10. Cable ties for securing scarecrows can be collected when registering.
- 11. Follow directions about where to install your scarecrow.
- 12. Take care when setting up your scarecrow. DO NOT damage property (public or private).

JUDGING

- 13. A judge will be selected by the committee of the Gulgong Arts Council.
- 14. Judging will take place on Saturday 8th June 2024. Winners will be notified thereafter.

PRIZES

- 15. A \$250 prize will be awarded in each of the following categories:
 - Scarecrow made by an individual
 - Scarecrow made by a school student or group of students
 - Scarecrow made by a family/business
- 16. There is also a \$250 People's Choice Award. Voting slips are available and can be lodged at the Memorial Hall on Saturday 8 June.

ADVICE

- 17. Materials used to build scarecrows will be exposed to weather and potential vandalism. We encourage the use of old, recycled materials.
- 18. Your scarecrow design may include props but we warn against using items of value.
- 19. Ensure all parts of your scarecrow are securely attached and do not pose a risk to the public.
- 20. Avoid using dangerous materials or materials that could become dangerous if damaged (eg glass)
- 21. Organisers retain the right to disqualify from entry, any scarecrow that may have unacceptable or offensive themes or messages.
- 22. Organisers retain the right to publish images of all entries.
- 23. You are responsible for collecting your scarecrow and any associated litter after 4pm on Saturday 8th June 2024. Scarecrows left overnight could become the victim of vandals.
